J. S. Bach's *Passion according to St. John* will be sung by the Sanctuary Choir of First Church under the direction of Donald F. Jensen on Sunday, April 3, at 4 p.m. Soloists include Ray DeVoll as the *Evangelist*, Sally Schmalenberger, Gwen Buttermore, J. Prentiss Haworth, David Norwine, Everett Holland, and Paul Grossmann. The work will be accompanied by Wilma Jensen, organist.

The organ at First Church was first heard at the Easter Sunday worship services last year. Built by the Aeolian-Skinner Organ Company, the instrument has 42 ranks of pipes. Additional copies of the dedication program, which also contain a stoplist of the organ, are available in the narthex.
